- Simple 'yes' or 'no' answer
- Establishing a base of knowledge





Yes/No Which Who When Where What How Why* What if

Which shoes does Pete love best?

- Introducing concept of 'not one correct answer'
- Respecting other people's opinions and answers





Yes/No Which Who When Where What How Why* What if

When does Pete begin to sing?

- Recognising that we have a choice on how we react to unexpected events
- Developing the Growth Mindset





Yes/No Which Who When Where What How Why* What if

Where can you find different coloured shoes?

- Processing knowledge
- Thinking outside of our immediate environment





Yes/No Which Who When Where What How Why* What if

What would you do if your best friend's clothes were ripped, stained or lost?

- Considering the well-being of others
- Remembering that we live in an interconnected world and we can influence others – positively or negatively

- Making connections between the world and people around them and you
- Learning to take responsibility for your choices and reactions

What if Pete came to your door and asked you to go for a walk with him? What would you most want to happen on that walk?


